

Camper Check List

BEDDING:

Bring twin sized sheets (top and bottom sheet) and pillow case. Blanket and pillow optional. If these are too cumbersome to transport, please notify the camp secretary to reserve a set for your camper. There will be a nominal charge to cover laundry costs. Please remember this is an Orthodox Christian camp. Use good judgment in selecting clothing. Conservative attire must be worn (beach wear, halter tops, bare midriffs or chests, see-through outfits or off the shoulders tops are not appropriate or acceptable). Artwork on clothing must also be in good taste (for example avoid offensive themes/ wording and alcohol or drug motifs).

Clothing Items (enough to last for duration of stay):

- Shorts/pants/blue jeans, skirts/dresses (include something appropriate for daily church services and liturgy).
- Shirts/blouses (one camp shirt will be provided).
- Socks
- Shoes (tennis shoes, dress shoes, sandals for use around pool)
- Underclothes
- Jacket/sweater or sweatshirt for cool evenings.
- Pajamas (bathrobe, slippers if desired)

Pool Items:

- Bathing suit - Modest. Female campers are required to wear a cover up over their bathing suits while outside of the pool area.
- Beach Towel
- Sunscreen (very important)

Grooming/hygiene items:

- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Soap, shampoo, deodorant
- Brush/comb, hair accessories if desired
- Towel and washcloth

Optional Items:

- Hair dryer
- Stuffed toy for young children
- Books
- Writing instruments, paper, postcards, envelopes and stamps

Please do not bring electronics (video games, stereos, etc). No skateboards. Three meals a day plus snacks are provided. Do not send any food with your child or to your child while they are at camp. Please mark all belongings with the camper's name. Camp cannot be responsible for lost or misplaced items.
